qui réside à Gisenyi.


Voudriez-vous m'accorder la mutation de


## The one minute concept

Therefore our choice of Stockholm feel so right – with the fantastic Globe Arenas close to the city centre, close to hotels, excellent communications, etc.

We think it is of great value for a WTTC if we can minimize the time between hotel and venue, between playing halls and practice hall, between hotel/venue and congress centre etc.

We are convinced that "One Minute Concept" is the most suitable name for our bid and we hope you will appreciate our efforts and support our request for the WTTC 2007.

22 students take part in daily practice apart from their normal studies at school.


As we mentioned in our first Newsletter we have two main options for the Swedish table tennis:

On behalf of the City of Stockholm I wish to announce our full support to the World Championships in table tennis in the Swedish Capital in May 2007.


Sweden has through the years had quite a lot of success in table tennis and it would be a great honour for our town to see you here in 2007.

The support from The City of Stockholm is total. As we shown you in our first Newsletter we also have a great support from The PrimeMinister of Sweden.


