which is quite undesirable and causes dissatisfaction
therefore we beg and request you to Consider the -
undermentioned Schemes

That the quantity of milk what much
may be the same should be directly sent to Mr -
alibhai Soumji, who will manage the distribution
among the merchants accordingly. By doing this -
the present trouble and complains will overdue.

further we beg you that this milk first
should be passed through the bureau where the -
quantity should be varified and chit to be given
and handed to Mr alibhai Soumji who will keep
the accounts of the same, and at the end of month
will make the payments and thus every -
trouble in this Connection will be ended.

Sir!

I respectfully beg to bring to your kind - information that I am the father of 8 Children, One of my Children is schooling outside the Country while 7 are here with me.. their ages are from years 12 - 9 - 8 - 6 - 4 - 1 $\frac{3}{4}$ and the youngest is of One month only who is borned at Shyira in last month.

The intention by this, is only to let you know my difficulties in need of milk which is the main question of - living of children and also of human beings as well.

I know very well the milk is very scarce here in Ruhengeri and the Condition is still going more worst, which is quite undesirable.

The present supply of milk of course is very poor but the management of distribution of same is far worst because the Capita who is incharge of it, is a very selfishness looking man he does what he wants that is to say - he supplies to certain people accordingly while to others not at all, I think there may be something wrong going on in this connection, if this is true, it must be strictly stopped by punishment so even in future no one could dare to make such mischiefs

On the 9th instant this Capita has purposely -

not supplied milk to me, that, when my boy went for it, the Capita refused him to give for me being having 2 bottles in balance after having been supplied to the Consumers. So my boy asked and begged him for those two bottles of milk, but the Capita totally disagreed, and beside this he asked my boy to tell me that I should go to the Administration to report him for this nuisance. Owing to this I went up to there to see the Capita in the matter where he replied me in the same manners just what he had told to the boy.

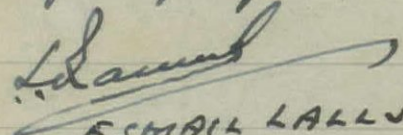
I am very sorry to disturb you in all the above matters, but I have no other ways except I should approach you in my difficulties, which are to be justified accordingly.

In all this time in shortage of fresh milk I used to continue with tinned milks, but these milks are no more obtainable so my difficulties and worries are more increased and these cause me heavy sufferings and feelings, which, you being a family man understand thoroughly and need no much explanations. Therefore I request your honour to be kind enough and make me an arrangement of atleast 4 bottles milk per day, which is not troublesome to obtain, if the present system of distribution is changed under proper basis.
